April 1 : Meeting in Council Chambers with OHM, Mayor Goodman, Council President Tom Wolf, Councilman John Lemmon, Development Director, Zoning Inspector and P/Z Clerk to discuss needed changes in the Code Plan per the Town Hall Meeting the meeting was an hour and half long and everyone posed their questions to OHM and it was clear at the end of the meeting what needed fixed and a timeline of two weeks for the Village to have the amended copy to allow it to be posted and available for distribution in a significant amount of time before the Towne Hall Meeting on May 11,2025 , that date is end of business April 15 for the Village to have the updates for review.
