AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SAFETY REGULATIONS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens and necessary for the proper protection and movement of fire equipment within the Village, that there should be no parking on any paved surface which constitutes a roadway or thoroughfare for vehicular traffic within the Village of Buckeye Lake;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: No person shall park, store or otherwise permit any motor vehicles on any portion of any pavement or similarly surfaced roadway, alley or thoroughfare ~~or sidewalk~~ within the Village of Buckeye Lake.

SECTION TWO: Any violation of this restriction shall upon conviction, constitute a minor misdemeanor punishable up to a \$100.00 fine for the first offense. For each subsequent offense within one year thereafter, such person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


