ORDINANCE NUMBER 2003-01

ORDINANCE HIRING A SOLICITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Village of Buckeye Lake retain the services of a Solicitor;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A)(2) requires public reading of a resolution to occur on three separate days, unless three-fourths (3/4) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE,

FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF 731.17(A)(2) TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Susan Kyte is hereby appointed Solicitor for the Village of Buckeye Lake for a period of one (1) year to be compensated at the rate of \$125.00 per hour.

SECTION 2: The Solicitor's duties shall be as outlined in the Ohio Revised Code, except that she shall not be required to prosecute cases in the Licking County Municipal Court;

SECTION 3: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake in that the filling of the position of Solicitor is immediately needed so that the Village may receive timely legal advice this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
