

**VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO**  
**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2003 - 10**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2003-6, THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Revised Code Section 5705.40, any appropriation ordinance or measure may be amended or supplemented, provided that such amendment or supplement shall comply with all provisions of law governing the taxing authority in making an original appropriation and that no appropriation for any purpose shall be reduced below an amount sufficient to cover all unliquidated and outstanding contracts or obligations certified from or against the appropriation; and

**WHEREAS**, the fiscal situation for the Village of Buckeye Lake has changed since the passage of Ordinance 2003-6, the permanent appropriations ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has been awarded three grants in the collective amount of approximately \$14,100 to be used for Fire Department equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$15,000 to be used by the Parks and Recreation Department for Ryan Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Buckeye Lake will require \$21,600 to be added to the general fund for purposes of the formation of a charter commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Buckeye Lake will require \$15,000 to be added to the general fund for purpose of legal fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Buckeye Lake will require \$15,000 to be added to the general fund for purpose of repairs to the Village Office roof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Buckeye Lake will require \$1,200 to be added to the general fund for purpose of additional costs associated with the State Financial Audit; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to pass this ordinance as an emergency measure to provide for the usual daily operations of the Village, which may be delayed by the requirement to read and enact an ordinance for each need as it arises and read such an ordinance on three separate days; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A)(2) requires public reading of a ordinance to occur on three separate days, unless three-fourths (3/4) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

**THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF 731.17(A)(2) TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO:

Section 1. That, the Village Council of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, in order to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures by the Village during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2003, provides that the following sums, in addition to those already provided for in the Permanent Appropriation Ordinance (Ord. 2003-6), be and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:
