

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-21

A ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DIANNA NEW DBA FOR THE LEASE OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5196 WALNUT ROAD, BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO 43008.

WHEREAS, a goal of Buckeye Lake Council is to continue to work with corporate entities for the continued development of commerce in Buckeye Lake;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to enter into an agreement with Dianna New DBA for the lease of property located at 5196 Walnut Road, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008 which shall be utilized as a bait and tackle retail sales and associated uses normally incident thereto and for no other person, or purpose;

WHEREAS, Council finds it is in best interest of the Village to enter into an agreement with Dianna New DBA for the continued development of commerce in Buckeye Lake.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A)(2) requires public reading of a ordinance to occur on three separate days, unless three-fourths (3/4) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF 731.17 (A)(2) TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio, 5 of the elected members concurring that:

Section 1. Buckeye Lake Village Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Dianna New DBA for the lease of property located at 5196 Walnut Road, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008 which shall be utilized as a bait and tackle retail sales and associated uses normally incident thereto and for no other person, or purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
