

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-16

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A WATER TAP FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Buckeye Lake has determined the appropriate tap fee rate for a $\frac{3}{4}$ " residential water tap inside the Village,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The tap fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for a $\frac{3}{4}$ " residential water tap inside the Village of Buckeye Lake is hereby established.

SECTION 2: This fee will be placed in effect and charged for customers within the Village effective April 16, 2010.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the need to put the charge in effect consistent with the previously established connection program within the Village, and therefore shall take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
