## ORDINANCE 2011-21 VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-04 SPECIAL PURPOSE FLOOD DAMAGE REDUCTION ORDINANCE FOR THE INCORPORATED PORTIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake adopted Special Purpose Flood Damage Reduction Ordinance 2007-04; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake needs to have fully compliant, legally adopted flood plain regulations to remain compliant with the FEMA National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, the FEMA Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) have been completed for the Village of Buckeye Lake; and

WHEREAS, the FIS and FIRM will become effective on January 6, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is required to adopt and/or amend their existing special purpose flood damage reduction ordinance prior to the FIS and FIRM effective date of January 6, 2012.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Ordinance 2007-04, section 1.6 is amended hereby to read:

- A. Flood Insurance Study Fairfield County, Ohio and Incorporated Areas and Flood Insurance Rate Map Fairfield County, Ohio and Incorporated Areas, both effective January 6, 2012.
- B. Flood Insurance Study Licking County, Ohio and Incorporated Areas and Flood Insurance Rate Map Licking County, Ohio and Incorporated Areas both effective May 2, 2007.
- C. Other studies and/or maps, which may be relied upon for establishment of the flood protection elevation, delineation of the 100-year floodplain, floodways or delineation of other areas of special flood hazard.
- D. Any hydrologic and hydraulic engineering analysis authored by a registered Professional Engineer in the state of Ohio which has been approved by the Village of Buckeye Lake as required by Section 4.3 Subdivisions and Major Developments.

Any revisions to the aforementioned maps and/or studies are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of these regulations. Such maps and/or

studies are on file at 5192 Walnut Road Southeast, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008.

- E. In addition, these regulations shall apply to Future Condition Flood Hazard Areas determined through FEMA approved certified engineering analysis. Future Conditions Flood Hazard Areas may be determined in the FIRM and FIS, or per Section 4.3 of these regulations.
- Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
