A RESOLUTION FORMERLY REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY PAY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE APPROXIMATELY .8 MILLS OF TAX REVENUE FORMERLY PAID BY RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE TO UNION TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, by formerly establishing a "paper township" removed itself from Union Township; and

WHEREAS, there were a small number of residents of the Village that also were residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the real estate tax millage paid to the Township of roughly .8 mills for 2014 should be paid to the Village,

NOW, WHEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio;

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the Village of Buckeye Lake hereby formerly requests that Licking County pay the additional tax available for tax year 2014, and any other appropriate years, in the amount of approximately .8 mills to the Village.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 2}}$: That this Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
